Pre-Anesthetic blood work is important to make sure your pet is healthy enough for anesthesia. Although blood profiles can identify potential anesthetic risks, it is important to realize it does not guarantee the absence of complications.

\$52.10 GOOD Healthy pets up to 4 years of age (Abaxis Prep Panel/PCV #2079)  
CRE /CREA/BUN (kidneys) ALP/ALT (liver) Glucose (sugar)  
Total Protein (healing ability, hydration) PCV (anemia)

\$85.70 BETTER Healthy pets 4-8 years of age (Abaxis Prep/CBC # 1835)  
CRE /CREA (kidneys) ALKP/ALT (liver) Glucose (sugar)  
Total Protein (healing ability, hydration) CBC (anemia, infection, clotting cells)

\$108.35 BEST Senior Pets (8 and older) or sick patients (Abaxis Compreh/CBC #1834)

This panel includes a more comprehensive look at internal organ functions (liver/ kidney/ pancreas) as well as a white and red blood cell count.

- \$16 \$ up Pain medication dispensed to help control your pet's pain at home. Your pet will receive adequate pain control at the time of surgery, but this usually wears off within 6-8 hours. Our doctors recommend continued pain control to keep your pet comfortable and healthy.  
(Price depends on medication doctor chooses, size of your pet, and procedure being performed.)
- \$10 & up Extract baby teeth, if needed. (Pets can have retained baby teeth that need to be removed)
- \$48.65 Canine Heartworm Test
- \$45.10 Feline FELV/FIV Test (Feline Leukemia & Feline Immunodeficiency Virus)
- \$40.20 Microchip - A microchip to identify your pet if ever he/she should get lost. This cost includes registration fee- no additional charges ever.
- \$14.35 Nail Trim (while under anesthesia)
- Update Annual Vaccines
